To mark the Diamond Anniversary of the Duke of Edinburgh's Award, we invite you to join us in a special celebration and challenge based here in Perthshire.

We hope those past and present participants, their friends and families, leaders and volunteers, and all those with an interest in the outdoors and "special places" will join us in this unique challenge.

It is a challenge that is open to all no matter what age or level of fitness.

The Challenge

During the period between 1 July 2016 and Friday 17 April 2017, we want 60 places of special interest in our county of Perthshire to be visited, and photographed, by anyone up for the challenge. Getting to them should involve a journey of some sort be it on foot, by bicycle, in a canoe, in a wheelchair – anything that you devise!

The 60 best photographs, one from each location, will be selected and bound into a special commemorative photo album which will be on sale for Christmas 2016. The album will include a list of the names of everyone who participated.
